Hockey Terms

- 1. Save- When a goalie blocks a shot
- 2. Assist- A pass that leads to a goal (up to two assists per goal)
- 3. Goal- When a shot puck completely crosses the goal line inside the goal
- 4. Point- Individual statistic awarded to a player for each goal or assist
- 5. Hat trick -3 goals scored by the same player in one game
- 6. Face off- When the official drops the puck between the sticks of two opposing players to start a play
- 7. Full Strength- When a team has all 6 players on the ice
- 8. Changing on the Fly- Substitutes can enter the game from the bench while play is in progress
- 9. Shorthanded- When, due to penalties, a team has fewer players on the ice than the opponent
- 10. Power Play- When a team has more players on the ice than the other team due to a penalty
- 11. Penalty Kill- When a team is shorthanded and attempts to prevent the other team from scoring
- 12. Minor Penalty- Most common penalty called. Player must go to penalty box without a substitution for 2 minutes or until the other team scores a goal.
- 13. <u>Major Penalty</u>- Called for more vicious violations. Player must stay in the penalty box without a substitution until the 5 minutes are up regardless if a goal is scored by the other team.
- 14. Penalty Box- Area on the opposite side of the ice in which a player sits to serve the penalty time
- 15. Stickhandling- Carrying/controlling the puck across the ice with the stick
- 16. Pass- Using the stick to direct the puck to another teammate

- 17. Wrist Shot- Shooting the puck off the blade of the stick with a flicking wrist motion
- 18. Slap Shot- Shooting the puck by swinging the stick back and then quickly forward
- 19. Left Wing- Forward who plays on the left side of the center
- 20. Center- Forward who plays in between the wingers
- 21. Right Wing- Forward who plays on the right side of the center
- 22. Defensemen- 2 players who defend their end of the ice
- 23. Goalie- guards the goal
- 24. Neutral Zone- area of ice between the blue lines
- 25. Attacking Zone- Zone between the opponent's blue line and the goal line
- 26. <u>Defending Zone</u>- Zone between your goal line and blue line
- 27. Icing- Occurs when a player shoots the puck across both the red line and the opposing team's goal line without it going in the net
- 28. Offside- A player may not skate with both skates into the attacking zone ahead of the puck
- 29. There are 3 periods in an NHL game and they are 20 minutes each.
- 30. Zamboni- The vehicle used to resurface the ice before the game and after each period
- 31. Overtime- Extra time played if the score is tied at the end of regulation
- 32. <u>Shootout-</u> Occurs if the score is tied after overtime. Each team sends out 3 players to take a penalty shot against the other team's goalie
- 33. Penalty Shot- When the puck is placed at center ice and a player skates in against the goalie with no other players on defense.
- 34. Breakaway- When an attacker is past all the defenders and skates alone against the goalie
